

Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.


This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

Remarks

- $\bullet \ \ U_{\rm out}$ is positive when $I_{\rm P}$ flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 105 °C.

- Dynamic performances (di/dt and delay time) are best with a single bar completely filling the primary hole.
